



The cleaning of your tank substrate with a gravel cleaner (sediment bell) to avoid poisonings by hydrogen sulphide or to eliminate this problem:

Your discus fish were doing fine for weeks or even months and suddenly they change their behaviour? They become shy, breath heavily and don't feel well?

The reason for this problem could be a poisoning by hydrogen sulphide because of a pollution of the gravel in the aquarium. Rotting gases from the ground cause rising bubbles when the substrate is moved.

You can avoid this poisoning or eliminate it with the cleaning of your substrate with a gravel cleaner, a so-called sediment bell. We recommend this procedure once a week.
