



Why are our STENDKER discus fish DIFFERENT?

Because over the course of more than 51 years of captive breeding in Germany we have acclimatised our discus fish to our German tap water, and because we feed them exclusively with our Good Heart feed. As a result, our STENDKER discus fish differ markedly from other discus fish. Asian captive-bred fish generally need a lot more water changes, for example, as they are raised without filters and therefore need more water to be changed much more often. Wild-caught fish have a completely different diet to our fish. With wild-caught fish, you also need to observe the 50 litres per fish rule, as it is much easier to emulate natural water quality in an aquarium with a lower fish density.
